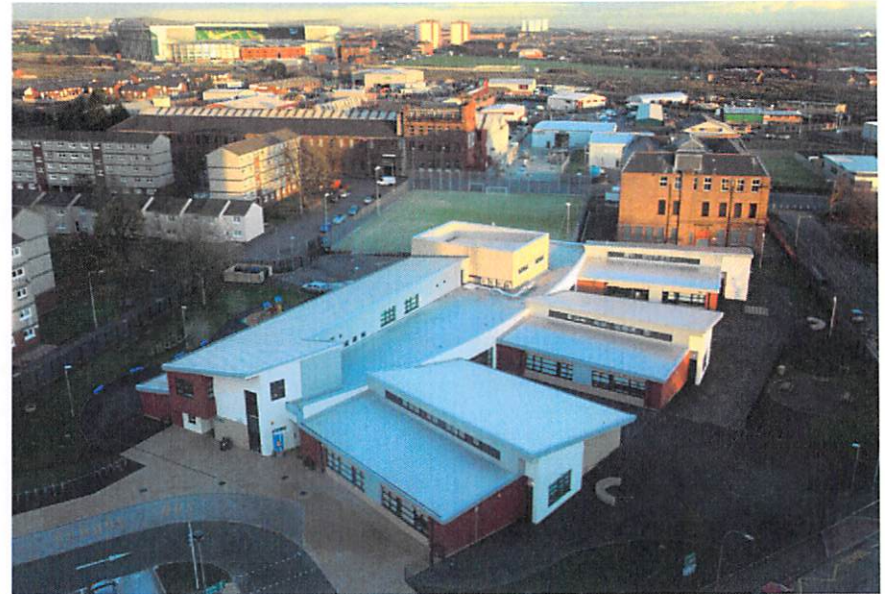
Henry May, VC
